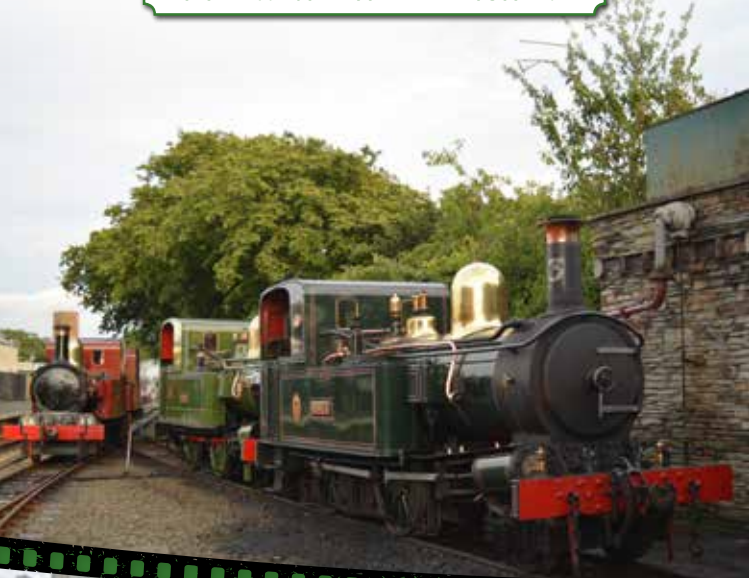

## MER PARALLEL RUN BETWEEN DERBY CASTLE AND GROUDLE



Commence our festival with the traditional Manx Electric Railway Parallel Run using G.F Milnes Cars 5 and 7. Both were delivered in 1894 and in recognition of the 130th Anniversary of the Groudle Glen to Laxey section of line the two Cars will be in service today. Departs Derby Castle at 08:50. Following the parallel run both Cars will remain in service throughout the day.

## MER G.F MILNES BULKHEAD TRAILERS AND TUNNEL CARS

To mark the line's 130th Anniversary between Groudle Glen and Laxey our tunnel Cars delivered in 1894 will be in service alongside veteran Unvestibuled Saloon Cars No.1 and No.2 of 1893. Cars will haul the adapted Bulkhead trailers on services today. Trailers will include: No.49 the first trailer supplied to the Manx Electric Railway in 1893 being hauled by 1893 Unvestibuled Saloon Car No.1; 1893 Trailer No.51 the third trailer supplied to the railway with 1894 Tunnel Car No.5.; 1893 Trailer No.54 with 1894 Tunnel Car No.7; G.F Milnes Trailers No.37 from 1894 in service with 1894 Tunnel Car No.9; and Trailer No.60 from 1896 and 1893 unvestibuled Saloon Car No.2.

Join representatives from Isle of Man Railways for an informal welcome to the 2024 Manx Heritage Transport Festival. The two 1874 Beyers, No.4 'Loch' and No.5 'Mona' will be presented at Port Erin Station to give various photo opportunities. Both locomotives were delivered as part of the Douglas to Port Erin line



completion in 1874. Also on display will be the 1921 'Fowler' Highway Board Road Roller and a collection of Goods Wagons in the Goods Shed Siding. The Museum will be open with guides available to speak with about the plans for the week ahead and The Whistlestop Café will be open for refreshments. No.4 'Loch' will depart Douglas Station at 17:30 with 1874 Pairs Coaches F.54, F.62 and F.63 providing an express service to Port Erin. 'Loch' will return from Port Erin to Douglas at 21:30 arriving back in Douglas for 22:30.

## CLOSED LINES BUS TOUR

Our bus leaves Douglas Railway Station at 09:00 with a commentary along the way. Before lunch highlights include the site of St. John's Station, Foxdale Station, the Knockaloe Camp Line, and the former Peel Station.
